Sixth period of year-on-year performance improvement

In the four weeks to 31 March, 93.3% of ScotRail trains met the industry target PPM measure. During the period ScotRail ran almost 2300 services each week day – allowing customers to make over 6 million journeys.



ScotRail announces 100 new electric car charging spaces

We are leading a drive to improve the availability of electric car charging points in stations. A total of 50 stations across the 359 station network will benefit from new, free to use charging points which can charge two cars at once. With the use of low-emission vehicles on the rise, ScotRail is keen to encourage their use, reducing carbon emissions by customers on their journey to and from the station.

Construction work to install the first charger will begin in September, with all 100 spaces available from November this year.
